Print, read, and bind your will

Print your will, read it through carefully, and make sure you understand it fully. If you need help or advice, please get in touch with our team at support@guardianangel.network.

Choose your witnesses

Once you're happy with your will and understand its contents, you need to find two "witnesses" to watch you sign your will and then sign it themselves. Witnesses should be:

- ✓ At least 18 years of age
- Someone who is not a beneficiary of your will
- Someone who is not married or related to a beneficiary of your will

If you're elderly or unwell, it is recommended to choose your GP as one of your witnesses. This will ensure that you understand your will.

3 Sign and date your will

With both witnesses present, sign your name in pen on the Your Signature page and write the date. Be sure to initial all of the other pages. Each witness should add their details in BLOCK CAPITALS and sign in pen as well.

Store your will

Your will is now finished and legally valid. Store it somewhere safe and make sure to let your executor(s) know where it is.
